This is normally a repeat for a complete side and will consist of multiple instructions.

() Repeat instructions between parentheses the amount of times specified.

This is a lower level repeat.

Special Stitches

Beginning Tr Cluster: Chain 3, yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

Tr Cluster: Yarn over twice, insert hook into indicated st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (4 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

Hint: corner chain spaces are not included in any stitch count.

1. Starting with a magic ring, ch 3 [*counts as dc*], dc, (ch 3, 2 dc) 3 times, ch 3. Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends.


Stitch count: 8 dc, 4 ch-3 spaces.



2. Make a beginning tr cluster in any ch-3 space [P1,2], (ch 4, tr cluster) in same space, *ch 4, skip next 2 sts, in next ch-3 space (tr cluster, ch 4, tr cluster). * Repeat from *to * 3 times, ch 4.

Join to starting tr cluster, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: 8 tr clusters, 8 ch-4 spaces.



3. Join with a standing dc in ch-4 space before any tr cluster pair [P1], **fptr** around next cluster, [P2]


*in next ch-4 space (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) [*corner formea*], **fptr** around next cluster,

5 dc in next ch-4 space, **fptr** around next cluster. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last dc and fptr.

Join to standing dc with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 9 dc, 2 fptr.



4. Ch 3 [*counts as dc*] [P1], **fptr** around next st [*fptr*], dc in next 2 sts,[P2]

*in ch-3 corner space (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) [P3], dc in next 2 sts, **fptr** around next st [*fptr*], dc in next 5 sts, **fptr** around next st [*fptr*], dc in next 2 sts. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last 4 sts [dc, fptr, 2 dc].

Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: per side: 13 dc, 2 fptr.



5. Join with a standing dc in last dc of any side, [P1]

*in ch-3 corner space (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) [P2], dc in next 4 sts, **fptr** around next st, dc in next 5 sts, **fptr** around next st, dc in next 4 sts. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last dc.

Join to standing dc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: per side: 17 dc, 2 fptr.



6. Join with a standing tr in any ch-3 corner space [P1], (ch 3, tr) in same space, [P2] *(ch 2, skip next st, sc in next st, ch 2, skip next st, tr in next st) 4 times [P3], ch 2, skip next st, sc in next st, ch 2, skip next st, in ch-3 corner space (tr, ch 3, tr). *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last corner group.

Join to standing tr with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 5 sc, 6 tr, 10 ch-2 spaces.



7. Ch 1, and sc in same st, [P1]

*in ch-3 corner space (sc, ch 2, sc), (sc in next tr, ch 1, tr in next sc, ch 1) 5 times, sc in next tr. * [P4]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last sc.

Join to 1st sc with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 8 sc, 5 tr, 10 ch-1 spaces. *Hint: your work will curl up at this point.*



8. Ch 6 [*counts as tr plus ch-2*] [P1], sc in next sc, ch 2, [P2]

*in ch-2 corner space (tr, ch 3, tr), ch 2, sc in next sc, (ch 2, tr in next sc, ch 2, sc in next tr) 5 times, ch 2, tr in next sc, ch 2, sc in next sc, ch 2. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last tr, ch-2, sc, ch-2.

Join to 4th ch with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 7 sc, 8 tr, 14 ch-2 spaces.




9. Ch 1 and sc in same st, ch 1, tr in next sc, ch 1, sc in next tr,

*in ch-3 corner space (sc, ch 2, sc), (sc in next tr, ch 1, tr in next sc, ch 1) 7 times, sc in next tr. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last sc, ch-1, tr, ch-1. Join to 1st sc, fasten off, and secure ends. Stitch count: per side: 10 sc, 7 tr, 14 ch-1 spaces.

Hint: your square will curl up at the corners.



10. Join with a standing dc in last st before any ch-2 corner space,

*in ch-2 corner space (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc), skip next st [*hidden st*] [P3], (dc in next st, dc in next ch-1 space) 14 times, dc in next 2 sts. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last dc.

Join to standing dc with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 34 dc.



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11. Ch 3 [*counts as dc*], dc in next 2 sts, *in ch-3 corner space (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc), dc in next 34 sts Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last 2 dc. Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends. Stitch count: per side: 38 dc.



Block all squares using same method as with Winnie's Flower square, start by pinning the centre square, then the mesh area, then the outer edge. Do not over stretch!
