* * Repeat instructions between asterisks the amount of times specified.

This is normally a repeat for a complete side and will consist of multiple instructions.

() Repeat instructions between parentheses the amount of times specified.

This is a lower level repeat.

Special Stitches

Beginning Dtr Cluster: Chain 3, yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

Dtr Cluster: Yarn over twice, insert hook into indicated st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (2 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (3 loops on hook), yarn over twice, insert hook into same st/sp, yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice (4 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

Hint: corner chain spaces are not included in any stitch count.

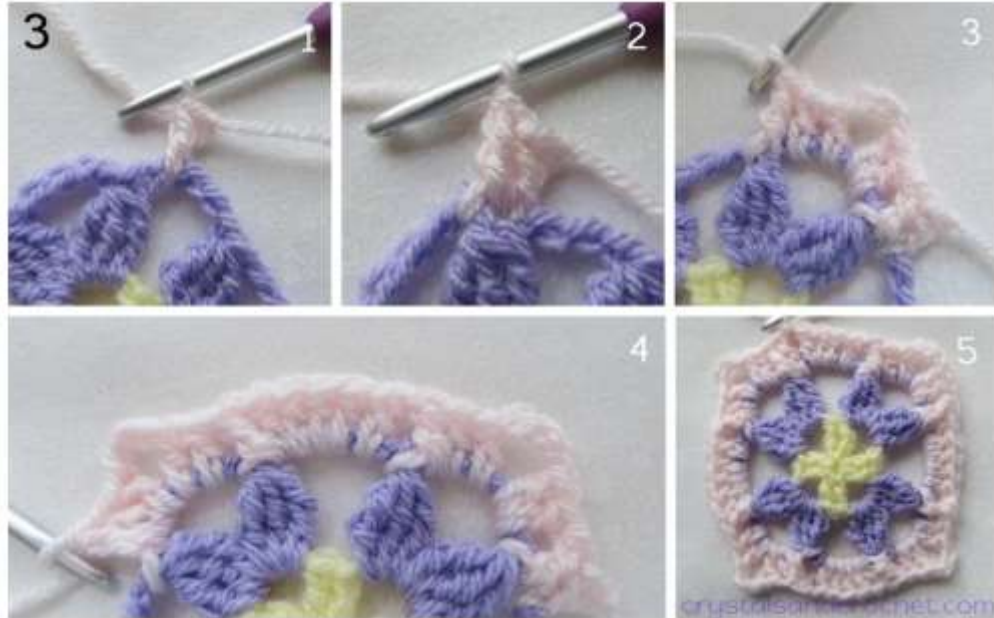
1. Starting with a magic ring, ch 3 [counts as tr], tr, (ch 3, 2 tr) 3 times, ch 3.
 Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: 8 tr, 4 ch-3 spaces.



2. Make a beginning dtr cluster in any ch-3 space [P1,2], (ch 4, dtr cluster) in same space,
 *ch 4, skip next 2 sts, in next ch-3 space (dtr cluster, ch 4, dtr cluster). *
 Repeat from *to * 3 times, ch 4.
 Join to starting dtr cluster, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: 8 dtr clusters, 8 ch-4 spaces.



3. Join with a standing tr in ch-4 space before any dtr cluster pair [P1], **fpdtr** around next cluster, [P2] *in next ch-4 space (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr) [*corner formed*], **fpdtr** around next cluster, 5 tr in next ch-4 space, **fpdtr** around next cluster. *
 Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last tr and fpdtr.
 Join to standing tr with a sl-st.
 Stitch count: per side: 9 tr, 2 fpdtr.



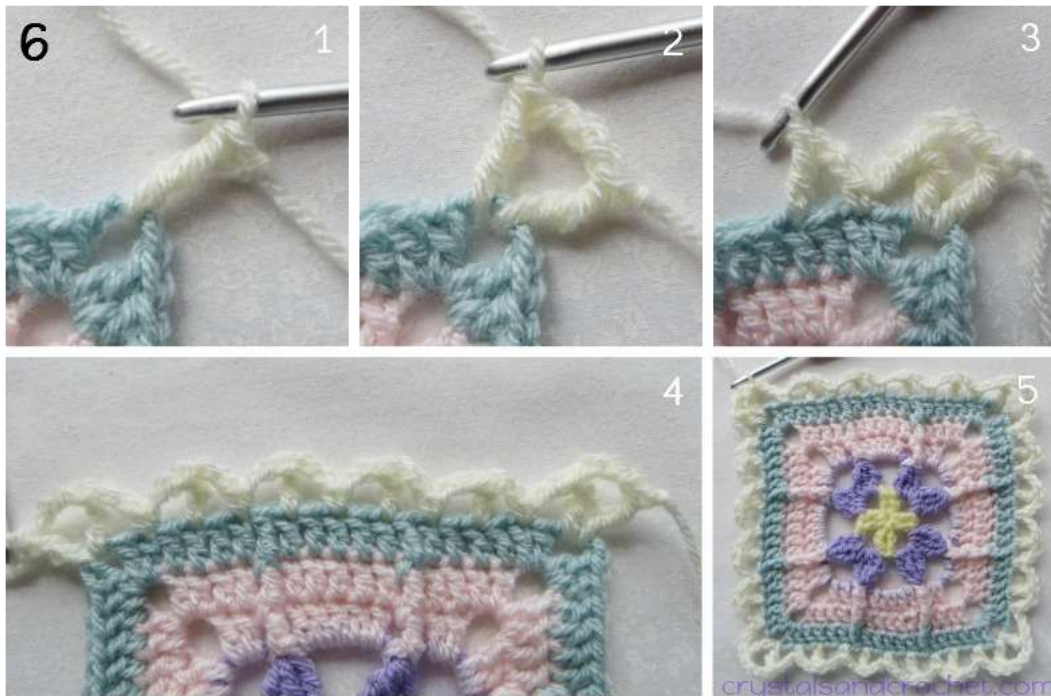
4. Ch 3 [*counts as tr*] [P1], **fpdtr** around next st [*fpdtr*], tr in next 2 sts,[P2] *in ch-3 corner space (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr) [P3], tr in next 2 sts, **fpdtr** around next st [*fpdtr*], tr in next 5 sts, **fpdtr** around next st [*fpdtr*], tr in next 2 sts. *
 Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last 4 sts [tr, fpdtr, 2 tr].
 Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: per side: 13 tr, 2 fpdtr.



5. Join with a standing tr in last tr of any side, *in ch-3 corner space (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr), tr in next 4 sts, fpdtr around next st, tr in next 5 sts, fpdtr around next st, tr in next 4 sts. * Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last tr. Join to standing tr, fasten off, and secure ends. Stitch count: per side: 17 tr, 2 fpdtr.



6. Join with a standing dtr in any ch-3 corner space [P1], (ch 3, dtr) in same space, [P2] *(ch 2, skip next st, dc in next st, ch 2, skip next st, dtr in next st) 4 times [P3], ch 2, skip next st, dc in next st, ch 2, skip next st, in ch-3 corner space (dtr, ch 3, dtr). * Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last corner group. Join to standing dtr with a sl-st. Stitch count: per side: 5 dc, 6 dtr, 10 ch-2 spaces.



7. Ch 1, and dc in same st, [P1]

*in ch-3 corner space (dc, ch 2, dc), (dc in next dtr, ch 1, dtr in next dc, ch 1) 5 times, dc in next dtr. * [P4]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last dc.

Join to 1st dc with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 8 dc, 5 dtr, 10 ch-1 spaces.

Hint: your work will curl up at this point.



8. Ch 6 [counts as dtr plus

ch-2] [P1], dc in next dc, ch 2, [P2]

*in ch-2 corner space (dtr, ch 3, dtr), ch 2, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dtr in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dtr) 5 times, ch 2, dtr in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2. *

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last dtr, ch-2, dc, ch-2.

Join to 4th ch with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 7 dc, 8 dtr, 14 ch-2 spaces.



9. Ch 1 and dc in same st, ch 1, dtr in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dtr,
 *in ch-3 corner space (dc, ch 2, dc), (dc in next dtr, ch 1, dtr in next dc, ch 1) 7 times, dc in next dtr. *
 Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last dc, ch-1, dtr, ch-1.
 Join to 1st dc, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: per side: 10 dc, 7 dtr, 14 ch-1 spaces.

Hint: your square will curl up at the corners.



10. Join with a standing tr in last st before any ch-2 corner space,
 *in ch-2 corner space (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr), skip next st [*hidden st*] [P3], (tr in next st, tr in next ch-1 space) 14
 times, tr in next 2 sts. *
 Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last tr.
 Join to standing tr with a sl-st.
 Stitch count: per side: 34 tr.



11. Ch 3 [*counts as tr*], tr in next 2 sts,
*in ch-3 corner space (2 tr, ch 2, 2 tr), tr in next 34 sts
Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last 2 tr.
Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends.
Stitch count: per side: 38 tr.



Block all squares using same method as with Winnie's Flower square, start by pinning the centre square, then the mesh area, then the outer edge. Do not over stretch!
