Be the belle of the ball with this beautiful light weight shawl, perfect with any evening dress, or as a cosy scarf type wrap in winter.

Recommended yarn ~ 2 balls of Stylecraft Cosy ~ 7mm hook

Or any light weight chunky yarn, you will need approx. 426 meters/466 yards

## Abbreviations

St, sts	Stitch, stitches	Ch	Chain	Sc	Single crochet
R	Row	Sl-st	Slip stitch	Dc	Double crochet

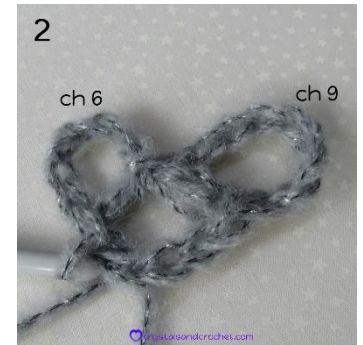
*[[ Hints: Are typed in italics and coloured purple, they are to help and guide you and hopefully make life a little easier, especially for beginners.*

() Repeat instructions between parentheses the amount of times specified.  
This is a lower level repeat.

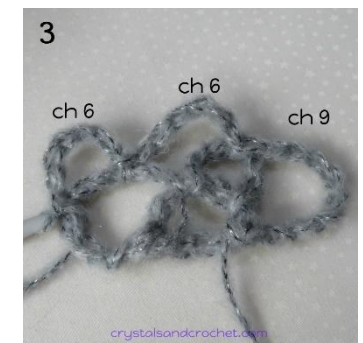
1. Ch 9 and join to 1<sup>st</sup> ch with a sl-st to form ring.



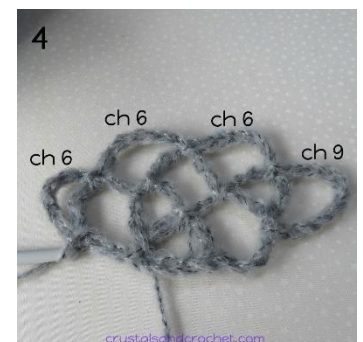
2. Ch 9, sl-st into ring, ch 6, sl-st into ring.  
Stitch count: 1 ch-9 loop, 1 ch-6 loop.



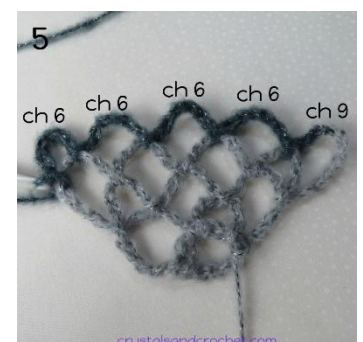
3. Turn, ch 9, sl-st into 1<sup>st</sup> ring,  
ch 6, sl-st into next ring,  
ch 6, sl-st into same ring.  
Stitch count: 1 ch-9 loop, 2 ch-6 loops.



4. Turn, ch 9, sl-st into 1<sup>st</sup> ring,  
(ch 6, sl-st into next ring) twice,  
ch 6, sl-st into same ring.  
Stitch count: 1 ch-9 loop, 3 ch-6 loops.



5. Turn, ch 9, sl-st into 1<sup>st</sup> ring,  
(ch 6, sl-st into next ring) 3 times,  
ch 6, sl-st into same ring.  
Stitch count: 1 ch-9 loop, 4 ch-6 loops.



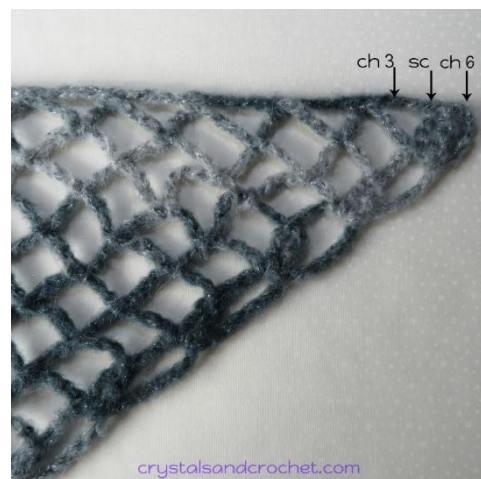
Continue for a total of 44 rows  
Stitch count: 1 ch-9 loop, 44 ch-6 loops.

Or until desired size is achieved.

Final row.

Turn, ch 6, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 44 times, ch 6, sl-st in same loop.

Fasten off and work away all ends.



## Roses

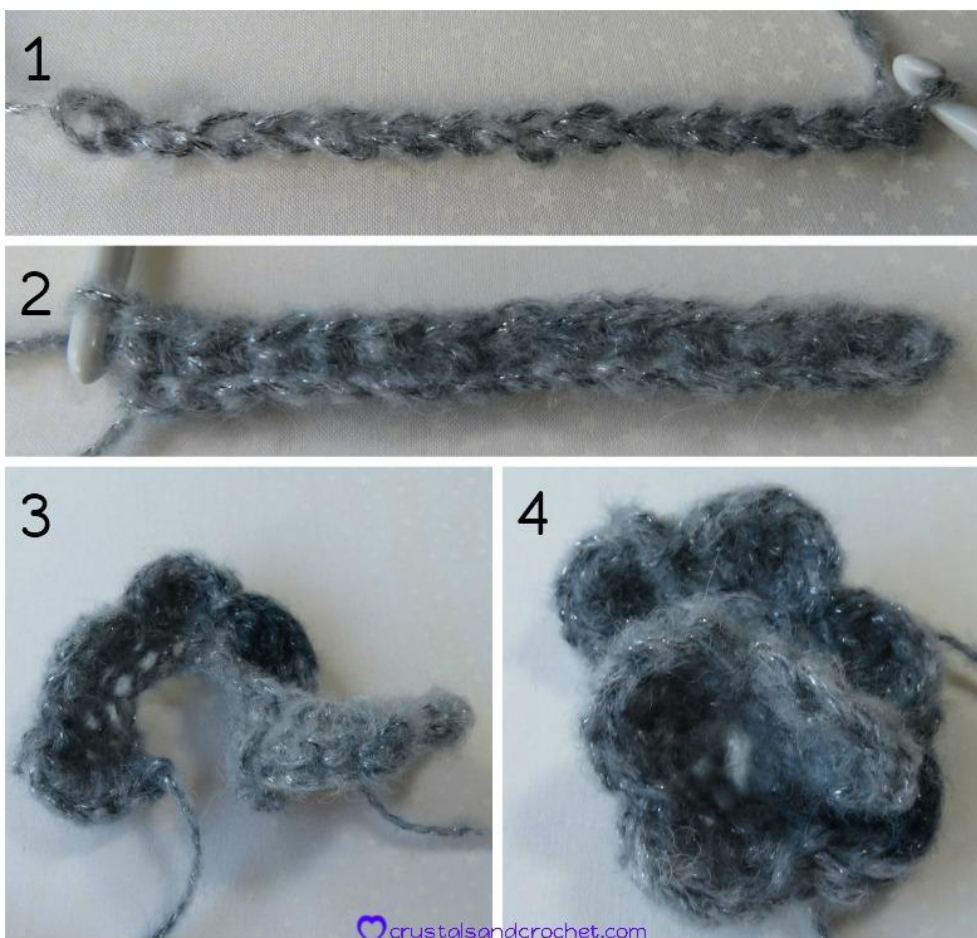
### Small rose.

Leaving a tail of approx. 12 inches/30 cm, ch 14, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch to end.

Turn, 5 dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, (sl-st in next st, 5 dc in next st) 6 times, sl-st in turning ch.

Roll to shape rose, ensure tail end drops through centre of rose.

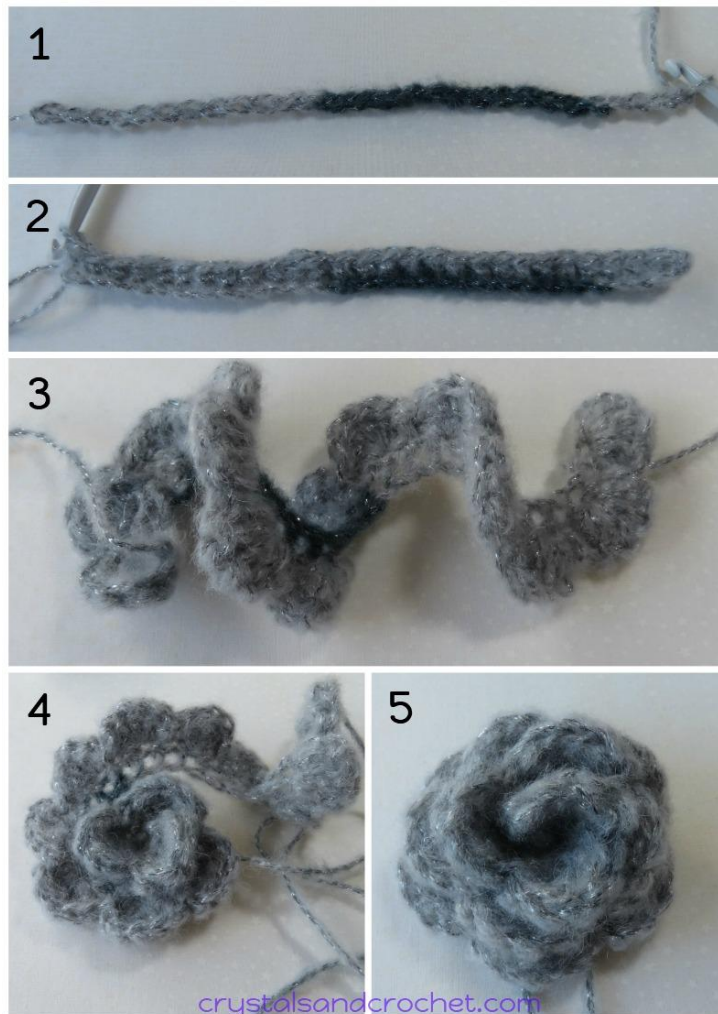
Using both tail ends, sew to shawl.



## Large rose.

Leaving a tail of approx. 12 inches/30 cm, ch 28,  
sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch to end.

Turn, 5 dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, (sl-st in next st, 5 dc in next st) 14 times, sl-st in turning ch.  
Roll to shape rose, ensure tail end drops through centre of rose.



Using both tail ends, sew to shawl, in any pattern you like.  
Here are two different ideas.

8 small roses plus 1 large rose



6 large roses
