12" square

Aran/worsted yarn 5mm hook.

Approx. 155m/170yds.

10" square

Double Knit yarn 4mm hook

Approx. 136m/149yds.

[] Hints: Are typed in italics and coloured purple, they are to help and guide you and hopefully make life a little easier, especially for beginners.

Reference to photos is [P] with the relevant photo number

* * Repeat instructions between asterisks the amount of times specified.

This is normally a repeat for a complete side and will consist of multiple instructions.

() Repeat instructions between parentheses the amount of times specified.

This is a lower level repeat.

Special stitches

Popcorn: Make 5 dc in same st, remove hook from loop and insert from front to back of 1st dc and then into dropped loop and pull through. Ch 1 to close. This closing chain is not counted in any chains you are asked to make after the popcorn.

To make a **beginning popcorn**, simply start with a standing dc or ch 3 as your 1st st.

Puff Stitch: Yo, insert hook in stitch or space yo and pull up a loop [*to height of adjacent sts*], 4 times (9 loops on hook), yo and pull through all 9 loops, and ch 1 to close. This closing chain is not counted as a stitch.

Double V stitch: (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st/sp.

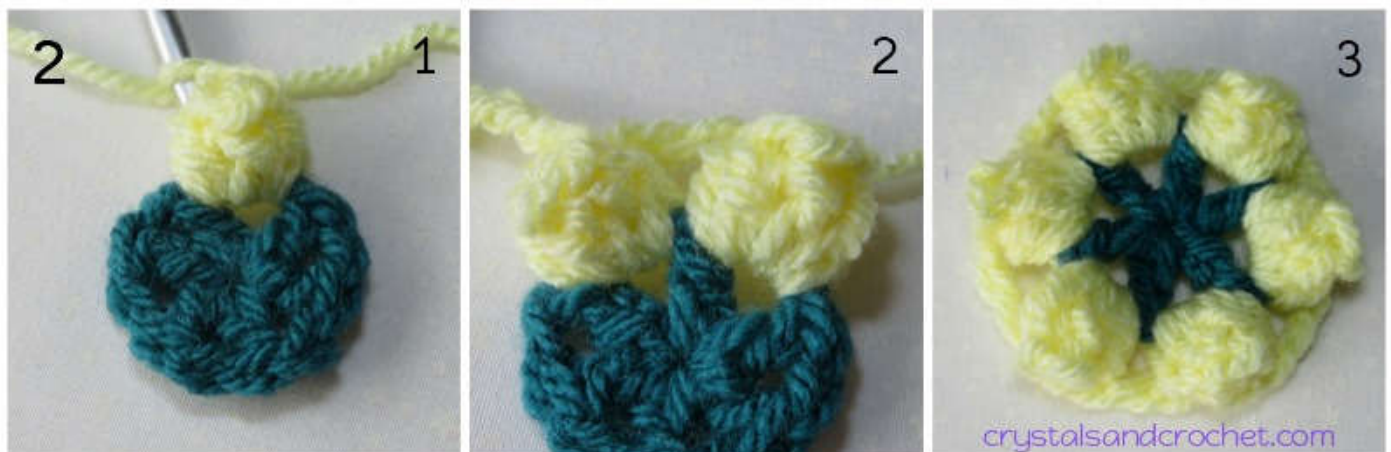

1. Starting with a magic ring, ch 4 [*counts as dc plus ch-1*], (dc, ch 1) 5 times. [P1]
 Join to 3rd ch, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: 6 dc, 6 ch-1 spaces.



2. Join with a beginning popcorn in any ch-1 space, [P1] (ch 3, skip next st, popcorn in next ch-1 space) [P2] 5 times, ch 3. Join to beginning popcorn, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: 6 popcorns, 6 ch-3 spaces.



3. Join with a standing sc in any ch-3 space, [P1] (in next popcorn ((dc, ch-1) 4 times, dc), sc in next ch-3 space) [P2] 6 times, omit last sc. Join to standing sc, fasten off, and secure ends.
 Stitch count: 6 sc, 6 shells of 5 dc, 4 ch-1 spaces each.



4. Join with a standing **bpdc** around last dc of any shell, [P1] (skip next sc, (**bpdc** around next st, hdc in next ch-1 space) 4 times, **bpdc** around next st) [P2] 6 times, omit last bpdc. Join to standing bpdc with a sl-st. Stitch count: 6 shells of 5 bpdc, 4 hdc each.



5. Ch 3 [*counts as dc*], [P1] (2 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts, dc in next 2 sts) [P2] 6 times, omit last dc. Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends. Stitch count: 30 hdc, 30 dc.



6. Join with a standing **bpdc** around any st, [P1] (**fpdc** around next st, **bpdc** around next st) [P2] 30 times, omit last bpdc. Join to standing bpdc with a sl-st. Stitch count: 30 fpdc, 30 bpdc.



7. Ch 3 [*counts as dc*], (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st [*forming double V-st*], [P1] (skip next 2 sts, double V-st in next st) [P2] 19 times. Join to top of ch-3, fasten off, and secure ends. Stitch count: 20 double V-sts.



8. Join with a standing dc in any double V-st, 3 dc in same st, [P1] (puff st between double V-sts, 4 dc in next double V-st) [P2] 20 times, omit last 4 dc. Join to standing dc, fasten off, and secure ends. Stitch count: 80 dc, 20 puff sts. *Hint: Your work will be wobbly.*



9. Join with a standing fpdc around any puff st, [P1] (bphdc around next 4 sts, fpdc around next puff st) [P2] 20 times, omit last fpdc. Join to standing fpdc with a sl-st. Stitch count: 20 fpdc, 80 bpdc.



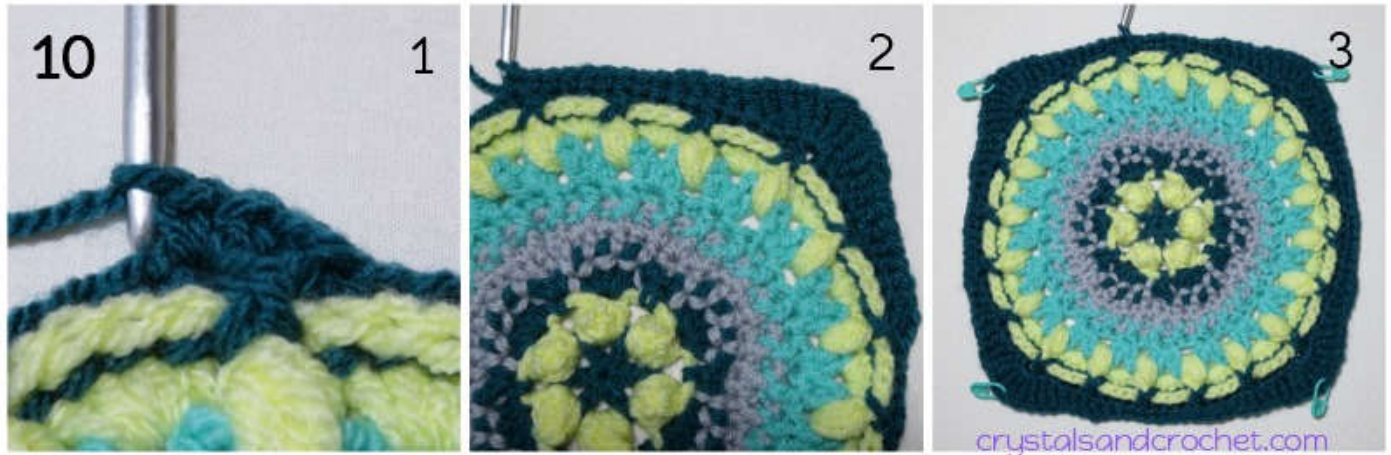
10. Ch 1 and sc in same st, sc in next st, [P1]

*hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, tr in next 2 sts, 5 tr in next st [*place marker in 3rd tr*], tr in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 8 sts. *[P2]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last 2 sc.

Join to 1st sc with a sl-st.

Stitch count: per side: 8 sc, 4 hdc, 8 dc, 8 tr, 1 corner tr.



11. Ch 1 and sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, [P1]

*hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, tr in next 3 sts, 3 tr in corner tr [*place marker in 2nd tr*], tr in next 3 sts, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 10 sts. *[P2]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last 3 sc.

Join to 1st sc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: per side: 10 sc, 4 hdc, 8 dc, 8 tr, 1 corner tr.



12. Join with a standing dc in any corner tr, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same st [*forming double V-st*], [P1]

*skip next 2 sts, (double V-st in next st, skip next 3 sts) 7 times, double V-st in corner tr. *[P2]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last corner double V-st.

Join to standing dc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: per side: 7 double V-sts, 1 corner double V-st.



13. Join with a standing dc in any corner double V-st, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same st, [P1]

*(puff st between double V-sts, 3 dc in next double V-st) 7 times, puff st between double V-sts, in corner double V-st (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc). *[P2]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last corner group.

Join to top of standing dc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: per side: 27 dc, 8 puff sts, 1 ch-2 corner space.



14. Join with a standing bphdc around last st of any side, [P1]

*6 sc in ch-2 corner space, [*place marker in 4th sc and leave in place to aid joining*], [P2] (bphdc around next 3 sts, fpdc around next st) 8 times, bphdc around next 3 sts. * [P3,4]

Repeat from * to * 4 times, omit last bphdc.

Join to standing bphdc, fasten off, and secure ends.

Stitch count: per side: 5 sc, 27 bphdc, 8 fpdc, 1 corner sc.



Work away all remaining ends.

Gently block to achieve a perfect 10/12 inch square, and a polished look to your work.
